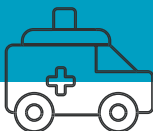
Pre-arrival

- Locate and furnish apartment
- Stock apartment with 2 weeks' groceries



48 hours

- Home visit with interpreter
- Review of safety and emergency services
- Overview of neighborhood, R1 services and contact info



30 days

- Enroll in employment services
- Enroll in English class
- Children enroll in school



Arrival

- Airport pick up with interpreter
- Cash pocket money provided to each person
- Hot, culturally appropriate meal
- Home and safety orientation



7 days

- Intake interview, overview of R1 services
- Cash pocket money and SIM card
- Application for SNAP, Medicaid, and cash assistance
- Social Security appt. scheduled
- Medical appt. scheduled



90 days

- Supplemental benefits applied for (SSI, WIC)
- Cultural Orientation workshops
- Rent and utilities assistance
- Employed or interviewing for jobs
- Attending English class regularly
- Screened for mental health services
- Referred for additional services



Ongoing services (90 days- 5 years)



Case

Management

- Reapplication for public benefits
- English class (or assistance enrolling in a community class)
- Housing support
- Mentor/adult ESL tutor

Wellness

- Individual or group therapy
- Medical case management
- Early childhood home visiting
- Dental care
- Psychoeducation
- Social emotional learning groups
- Referrals to other mental health services



Youth

- School support for students and parents
- After school and summer program
- Youth mentor and tutor program
- Field trips and holiday parties
- Parent education
- School supplies

Employment

- Job upgrades
- Sewing Studio
- Support applying for higher education or vocational training

Immigration

- Applications for Adjustment of status and citizenship
- Referrals for asylum application process
- Family reunification
- Citizenship classes
